### SNAPCHAT #DIVINE\_IMAGES SERMON SERIES

After the long wait in expectation of the birth of Jesus, after the tradition of the 12 Days of Christmas, the Light of the World breaks through! The Christian Season of Epiphany began on January 6th and will run through March 3rd. In worship during those weeks we will be using the social media platform called "Snapchat." Snapchat began life as a simple idea to connect people by snapshots in time. Quick pictures that come and go. A flash of an event, a piece of a story, an opportunity to ask for more. It has evolved over time, but Snapchat is still about pictures and video, sharing stories and commenting on the moods of the stories with mostly funny filters that "enhance" the pictures. This Epiphany season we are taking this Snapchat concept and using it as our own filter to consider the snapshots in creating a big picture story of God-with-us...and God within us. #### NATIONAL BLUE BLOOD DRIVE


Chapel Hill's American Red Cross "National Blue Blood" Drive, held this past Saturday was a big success. The weather was a concern heading into the morning, but the snowfall didn't stop the 54 registered donors from donating 57 pints of blood, which exceeded our goal of 49 pints! Chapel Hill collaborated with several local law enforcement departments to bring awareness to M.I.C.O.P.S., the Michigan chapter of C.O.P.S., an organization that provides support to families and communities of police officers killed in the line of duty. 22 volunteers from Chapel Hill helped make this drive a success. Chapel Hill always gives strong support to the blood drives we host, and certainly didn't disappoint at this drive which brought in more donors, Red Cross staff, and police officers. Nourishment was given to all, not only by way of a large variety of soups and snacks, but also friendly hospitality. Many donors shared that they enjoy our drives so much, they will plan to return at our next drive, which will take place on June 22, 2019.
