What is fun for you?

"I enjoy setting aside an hour every week for myself to build these relationships and increase my faith. I enjoy watching the videos and having time to discuss it afterwards. I love that there is no homework which makes it fun for me. It is a time for me to connect with other members of the church and to do something for myself."

How has it impacted your faith journey?

"I was hesitant to start a small group partially due to the fact that many groups were reading books and having homework to be able to participate in the discussion. With my busy life and small children I was struggling to find time to put forth the effort to be prepared. This group has been great because I can just show up. Small group has helped me to see things from others' perspectives. It has brought me meaningful relationships and new friendships. It has brought me closer to God by discussing life and everyday issues and be able to see the big picture and how God and Jesus play a role in my life today."


