DID YOU KNOW?

Realm is a shared field of interest. Our shared field of interest at Chapel Hill is in being a transforming community of faith. Staff have been working on transitioning our old database (where we store names, addresses, phone numbers, etc.) to a new program called Realm. Realm is a highly secure tool that allows us each to manage our own profile, and allows us to connect with others in groups. It is all about building better communication. Information is accessed by computer, or smartphones. Messages can be sent to individuals, groups, or staff and leaders. Like our old database, this program enables church staff to handle contributions, attendance, and filing in demographic groups. But Realm does more that matters to us in being Chapel Hill. This is a tool to connect easily and more meaningfully and share experiences together, while coordinating information, communication, resources, and administration. Pastor Barry, Deacon Pat, Sue Dueweke, and Andrea Tramel attended training last month with Realm experts. We are starting to softly introduce Realm to staff, Core Team leaders, and some small groups. Eventually, Realm will be “rolled out” to the whole congregation. We are excited about the possibilities of this very easy to use tool for our many ministries together.

The Naked Church: Conversations on Faith and Sexuality

The United Methodist Church continues to struggle with a consistent teaching, message and polity on human sexuality. Pastor Barry is inviting Chapel Hill to an afternoon of conversation on where we are as a local church and as a denomination in understanding sexuality as it relates to a faith community with "Open Hearts, Open Minds, Open Doors" as its marketing tag line. It has been 20 years since Chapel Hill adopted a welcoming statement that includes "homosexual persons" in the list of the embraced in welcome. Much has happened and is happening in our understanding of human sexuality since that document was debated and affirmed. So, Pastor Barry and some members of the community that are working on matters of faith and sexuality will lead a discussion on where we are going as a culture, congregation, community and global church on matters most basic to us as human beings seeking to be in faithful relationship with others and with God.
