TAKING THE NEXT STEP:

Summer is a trickling kind of time. Some things slow down while other things get busy. Ironic, right? Yet, it seems to be the case. The summer slowdown has even affected the "Taking The Next Step" process. Church leadership and staff have seen the return of the estimate of giving cards slow down to a trickle. But we are not discouraged! So far 103 households and individuals have estimated 2018-2019 financial giving at a hair under \$500,000. We have a ways to go before we feel confident that Chapel Hill folks will support the ministries projected in the next year. And that is just the financial giving. Cards also contain information on the giving of prayer, presence, service and more. Being Disciples of Jesus means giving for a shared vision of ministry in and through the Church. In this way we can continue Chapel Hill's vision of being "a home where each person belongs to God and so to one another; a household of faith where each discovers the call and responds."
