Kids will participate in a large group activity, watch a video and then spend time with their own age group to discover the Bible story at their own level. Each week kids will get a special take home sheet to help families talk about the lesson at home. Parents/Guardians will pick up their kids downstairs in Room 109 at 12pm.
